*Inmate Scanning In and Out*

**Summary:**

A Federal Correctional Institution uses Keychain Synch to scan inmates going in and out of an area. One keychain scanner is used for the “In” scans and the other is used for the “Out” scans. Proxis Software’s Keychain Synch employs an option to create a separate data directory for each scanner. By comparing the scans in the In folder to the scans in the Out folder this agency can have complete access control on a given area.

The Keychain Synch software downloads barcode scans from a keychain barcode scanner like the Opticon OPN2001 or Symbol CS1504, stores them in a text file and Access database, and can even upload these text files automatically to an FTP server for processing or import into an ordering system.

Keychain Synch is digitally signed and tested rigorously to ensure its safety and security when deployed in various customer facing environments.
